Students may not use credits taken to satisfy general education to count toward their required 18 hours.

**World Language Requirements:**

*Student seeking the degree of Bachelor of Arts must complete one of the three options listed below:*

- 1) Completion of the second level of a world language (course number 102).  
 \*Student may test out of the course  
 \*Completion of a world language course above 102 with a grade of C or better will satisfy the requirement
- 2) Completion of WL 100, Intro to Comparative Linguistics, & ANTHR/ENG 106, Language Thought and Culture.
- 3) Completion of the second level of American Sign Language.

**B.A. Major Requirements:****Institutional Graduation Requirements:**

- Total of 120 semester hours, minimum.  
 Complete a minimum of 40 semester hours in upper-division courses.  
 Overall cumulative grade point average of 2.00.  
 A minimum of 60 semester hours must be earned from a four -year institution. Of these, a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit must be earned in residence.  
 Of the last 30 semester credits earned immediately preceding graduation, no more than 15 may be completed at other colleges or universities.  
 All other requirements as specified in the Catalog.

**Additional Major Graduation Requirements:**

- No grade lower than a C will count toward the major.  
 Students are required to take 30 hours of major courses in residency.
